# PORT DUES

(Final draft)

Port of Rijeka Authority Riva 1, CRO - 51000 RIJEKA CROATIA Pursuant to Art. 38, Paragraph 1, Item 10 of the Sea Ports Act (Official Gazette No. 108/95), the Governing Board of the Port of Rijeka Authority, at it 3rd session held on August 30, 1996, fixed the following port dues rates effective from **September 1, 1996.** 

THE PORT DUES RATES were amended by the decision of the Governing Board:

### I. QUAY DUES

#### A. **PROVISIONS**

- Quay dues are to be paid by vessels making use of the port for the purpose of embarkation or disembarkation of passengers and cargo loading/unloading (Paragraph 3, Art. 62 of the Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act).
- 2. Quay dues are not to be paid by Croatian public and Croatian warships, lighters/bum-boats and yachts (Paragraph 6, Art. 62 of Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act).
- 3. Unit of measure for quay dues computation: loaded/unloaded tonne of cargo (whole tonnes only) and embarked/disembarked passengers.
- 4. The ship should pay invoices covering quay dues, made out by the Port of Rijeka Authority, within the issuance period of the invoice.
  If the payment is not made within that time, the Port of Rijeka Authority will charge legal interest on arrears.
- 5. The Port of Rijeka Authority, with the Governing Board's consent, may accord a reduced rate of quay dues to ship owners whose cargo ships, by the frequency of their callings and by the realised cargo traffic, make considerable contribution to the development of Rijeka's traffic direction.
- 6. For cargo in transhipment, dues are charged only when unloading.

\*Vessel shall not pay a due for cancelled berth reservation if the reason for canceling is the case of force majerue.

#### II. WHARFAGE

#### A. **PROVISIONS**

- Wharfage is to be paid by ships staying in ports for any purpose except for embarkation or disembarkation of passengers, and/or loading or unloading of cargo (Paragraph 4, Art. 62 of the Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act).
- 2. Croatian public and Croatian warships, lighters/ bum boats and yachts are exempt from wharfage (Paragraph 6, Art. 62 of the Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act). A ship staying in the port for the purpose of disembarkation of saved shipwrecked persons; deceased or sick persons, and their escort; and for administering medical aid to the persons on board, are also exempt from wharfage but only during the time of such occurrences. Also exempt from wharfage are: vessels seeking shelter because of bad weather; vessels unable to set to sea in bad weather conditions if there is a risk to the vessel's safety; embarked persons and loaded cargo on the condition they can prove exemption for each such event with relevant documentation issued by certified navigation safety authorities.
- Unit measures for computation of wharfage:
   meter of length of the occupied pier by day (whole days only) and
   loaded tonne (whole tonnes only) (for bunkering fuel lubricants and water).
- 4. A ship shall be charged for wharfage upon expiration of the time required for loading/unloading, a passenger ship upon expiration of the time allowed for the stay in port according to the sailing schedule. Wharfage shall commence 2 hours after termination of loading/unloading cargo, embarkation/disembarkation of passengers respectively.
- 5. Exceptionally and in justified cases, due to the special circumstances when officials of the state administration (officials of harbour master's office, port authorities, customs, police)

are not able to conduct the prescribed procedures and actions that precede the departure of the ship from the port within two hours after the expiration of the time estimated for loading / unloading of goods, the computation of the wharfage will start immediately after obtaining the ship departure permits issued by the port harbour master's office.

- 6. If, upon expiration of the time necessary for loading/unloading cargo onto/from the ship, the crew has to perform port operations for which the Port of Rijeka Authority has granted concession to a particular company (lashing, shifting cargo etc.), wharfage for the port utilisation shall be calculated on the basis of the rates listed in this Table, increased by 100%.
- The Port of Rijeka Authority shall make out an invoice for wharfage, which the ship is obliged to pay within the issuance period of the invoice.
   Failing this, the Port of Rijeka Authority shall charge the legal interest on arrears.
- Exceptionally, at the request of the agent of the ship, the amount of wharfage may be reduced if the ship remains in port after the expiration of two hours of completed loading / unloading of cargo and passengers as a result of:
  - Long preparation of the ship in case they subsequently observed deficiencies in the storaging and securing (strengthening) of cargo, which could endanger the safety of the crew, ship and cargo if they are not eliminated before departure or when there is a failure on the part of the ship or electronic devices directly before scheduled sailing out, which must be removed to preserve the safety of the crew, ship and cargo;
  - Inability to departure due to bad weather;
  - Compliance schedule in other ports;
  - Delay in the planned shift crew for the occurrence of circumstances during a trip that can not be influenced, for example, flight cancellation, health problems, congestion in the road and / or rail traffic, etc., and also other justifiable case that was not to be anticipated or eliminated.

Wharfage in above mentioned cases is calculated as follows:

- For the first 24 hours after the end of two hours of completed operations loading / unloading of cargo and passengers will be charged 25% of the amount under the tariff;
- For the next 48 hours after the expiry of the previous 24 hours will be charged 50% of the scheduled tariff;
- For further extension of stay of the ship in the port after the expiry of the term stipulated in the preceding items (2 + 72 hours) wharfage is calculated at the full prescribed rate.
- 9. An anchorage fee shall be paid by a vessel that does not intend to carry out commercial loading / unloading activities at the port of Rijeka and which has previously obtained the approval for anchorage by the Port of Rijeka Authority.

#### III. BERTHAGE

#### A. PROVISIONS

- Berthage is to be paid by the owners of fishing ships, yachts, fishing and sports boats, other types of boats and floating objects (Paragraph 5, Art.62 of the Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act).
- 2. Berthage is not chargeable to Croatian public ships, Croatian warships and lighters/bum boats and yachts (Paragraph 6, Art.62 of the Maritime Demesne and Sea Port Act).
- 3. The Port Authority of Rijeka, upon request, allows annual berth. Fishing ships and boats, ships and boats performing commercial activities, yachts and floating objects may use one-time berths on the passenger pier and are charged for berthage by day (whole days only).
- 4. The unit of measure applied in the calculation is vessel for annual berth, while the calculation for of one-time berthage is based upon the vessel's meter length.
- 5. From November 30, the Port Authority of Rijeka determines the number of available permanent berths for the following year. Throughout December, interested parties shall send their requests to the Port Authority of Rijeka for the permanent berths for the following year.

Current customers will have priority when applying berth for the following year, in case they have settled all obligations.

6. Fee for annual berth is to be paid by January 31 of the current year, according to the terms and conditions stipulated in the Berthing Contract.

- 7. The one-time berth on the passenger pier is used by ships, boats and floating objects that are moored alongside other ships, shall incur a charge of 50% of berthage.
- 8. The Port Authority of Rijeka may negotiate a contract with repeated users of one-time berth for an annual lump-sum compensation of berthage. Such annual lumps-sum compensation shall be according to the terms and conditions stipulated in the Contract on the annual lump sum payment for berthing.
- 9. Upon the request of the Port Authority of Rijeka, both the users of permanent, annual and one-time berths are required to temporarily remove their vessels when such measure is made necessary by the situation in the port, without any right of compensation. If the berths are not made free within the stated time, the Port Authority of Rijeka will take such action at the expense of the vessel's owners.
- 10. The permanent berthing request for vessels can be issued exclusively for vessels that perform activities related to the safety of navigation within the port of Rijeka (such as towing , mooring and unmooring services, pilotage), and the environmental protection of waters . \*
- \*This regulation has been applied since 1. February 2015.
- With regard to the occupancy rate, the Contract on the annual lump sum payment for berthing at the Rijeka breakwater can be issued only to existing users - the signatories of the Contract, for the existing fishing boat / boat.

The contract with the new user of the berth may be concluded only for fishing ship / boat in case some of the existing berths are released, due to the withdrawal of existing users from conclusion of the new contract or in case of user's death according to the Plan for berths allocation.

- 12. Contract on the semiannual / annual lump sum payment for berth can be concluded with frequent users of one-time berth for berths between piers Istarsko and Gat Karolina Riječka (Passenger pier, berths number 3 and 7), depending on berth occupancy.
- 13. Taxpayers who pay a bond fee in foreign currency will be charged the amount equivalent to HR kuna according to the Croatian National Bank's Middle Exchange Rate valid on 1 January and 1 July of the current year.

The lump semiannual / annual payment for berthing fishing boats / vessels is calculated at the cost of Kn 1.00 / meter / day, except for the port Torpedo where the annual lump sum is calculated at the cost of Kn 2.000,00 for boats and 4.000,00 for ships.

The lump semiannual / annual payment for berthing boats on passenger pier between piers Istarsko and Gat Karolina Riječka (Passenger pier, berths number 3 and 7) is calculated at the cost of Kn 4.00 / meter / day.

For catamarans and trimarans price of berth is increased by 50%.
